STANDING ORDER NO. 5

(Limited English Proficiency / Language Access)

Pursuant Criminal Proceeding Interpreter Act (725 ILCS 140/0.01, et seq.) ("Interpreter Act"), this Court is required, upon its own motion or that of defense or prosecution, to "... determine whether the accused is capable of understanding the English language and is capable of expressing himself in the English language so as to be understood directly by counsel, court or jury. If the court finds the accused incapable of so understanding or so expressing himself, the court shall appoint an interpreter for the accused whom he can understand and who can understand him." 740 ILCS 140/1. The Court is also required to "... enter an order of its appointment of the interpreter who shall be sworn to truly interpret or translate all questions propounded or answers given as directed by the court." See 740 ILCS 140/2; see also Illinois Supreme Court Language Access Policy (10/1/2014).

To insure compliance with the Interpreter Act, the Court ORDERS as follows:

- 1. Whenever the <u>State or Defense counsel</u> have reason to believe that a Defendant in Courtroom D is not fully capable of understanding the English language and/or is not fully capable of expressing him- or herself in the English language, the State or the responsible Defense attorney(s) shall make a record of the Defendant's lack of or limited English proficiency and shall request the entry of an Order for an Interpreter appointing an Interpreter for the Defendant who is capable of translating the Defendant's language into English and English into the Defendant's language.
- 2. Defense counsel for a Defendant with limited English proficiency shall provide his or her Defendant with the Interpreter Request Form approved by the Illinois Supreme Court and available at the Illinois Supreme Court's web site for download. A copy of the "Request & Order For an Interpreter" is also attached to this Standing Order as **Exhibit A**.
- 3. At the earliest possible opportunity following the Defendant's first appearance in Courtroom D, Defense counsel shall submit, on his or her Defendant's behalf, a completed Request & Order for Interpreter for the Court to review and enter as appropriate. Upon entry of the Order, the Circuit Clerk shall identify the Defendant as needing an interpreter and shall identify the language needed on the docket of the Defendant's case. Defense counsel shall thereafter insure that arrangements are made ahead of court appearances through Trial Court Administration (Monica Minnis, Language Access Facilitator) for the presence of an interpreter or for the anticipated use of the Language Line interpretation service.
